

Tobacco Sale Prohibition (Automatic Prohibition) Orders

Peel Public Health inspects tobacco retailers for compliance with the Smoke-Free Ontario Act, 2017.

If the owner of a tobacco retail location in Peel Region is convicted of a tobacco sales offence at that retail location, and if that owner, or a previous owner was convicted of a separate tobacco sales offence at the same address, within the preceding five years, Peel Public Health will request a “*Notice of Prohibition Against the Sale, Supply, Storage and Delivery*” (also known as an “Automatic Prohibition (AP)”) from the Ministry of Health. If granted, this Notice would prevent the retail location from being able to sell, supply or store tobacco on site for a defined period of time.

Automatic Prohibition Orders will be posted for two years from the effective date. The following businesses have received an Automatic Prohibition (AP) Order in the past two years.
