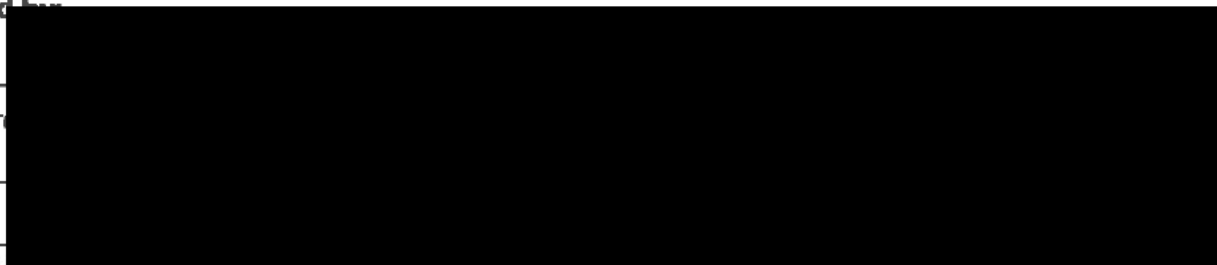

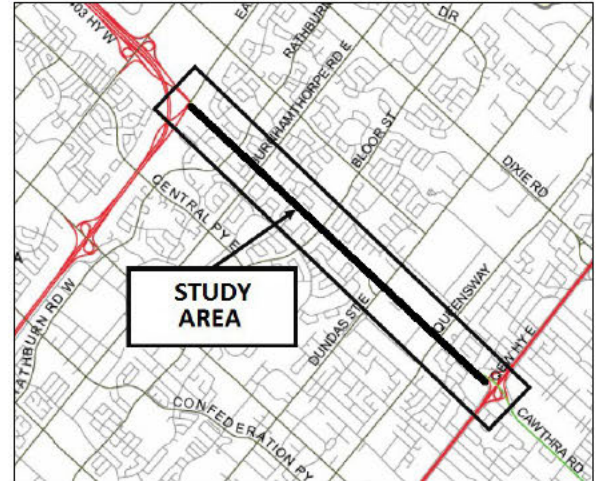

The Study

The Region of Peel is conducting a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study for Cawthra Road from QEW to Eastgate Parkway in the City of Mississauga (see map). The study is examining the needs and opportunities for transportation improvements within the Cawthra Road corridor to:

- Better serve the needs of all road users,
- Maximize the use and capacity of the road right-of-way, and
- Improve operations and safety for all road users.

A feasibility study was completed in 2014 that concluded that a widening of Cawthra Road from QEW to Eastgate Parkway is not warranted. Recommendations include maintaining the existing four lane cross-section (with centre turn-lane in some sections) with intersection improvements, and exploring opportunities to enhance active transportation by providing on-road bicycle and/or boulevard multi-use facilities. The Class EA Study will build upon the findings of the feasibility study.



The Process

This Study is being conducted in compliance with Schedule 'B' of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, which is a process approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

Thank you for your comments on the draft Stage 1 Archaeological Assessment report. The project team has reviewed your comments and Archeoworks Inc. has updated the report as follows:

1. additional Stage 2 work is recommended in the vicinity of two cemeteries and for lands with no apparent signs of extensive sub-surface disturbance, and,
2. additional information is provided for lands which formed part of the Cherry Hill House at the northwest corner of Dundas Street and Cawthra Road. The affected area does not retain archaeological potential due to heavy modification over the years. Previous reporting on the area also suggested that the best area to investigate lies to the west of the old Cherry Hill House location, and not the area fronting Cawthra Road, which lies to the east.

Attached is a copy of the updated report dated March 1, 2020. Please let me know if you have any further comments on the archaeological assessment.

Good Afternoon Asha,

We happened to be doing unrelated research and happened to come across some additional materials related to known Mississauga sites within the City of Mississauga. One that jumped out at me for your project is the Cherry Hill site (AjGv-18) originally located at Cawthra and Dundas. I looked at Archeoworks report again, and they have no indication in their report that this site, while known as the original location of the Cherry Hill designated heritage house, is also known to be the vicinity of historic Mississauga encampments. Knowing this, we would like to see that the stretch of the corridor adjacent to this area, though limited, is also targeted as an area of Stage 2 investigation. I have attached the Ontario Archaeological Society Publication that discusses the OAS' salvage excavation efforts in the 1972 (Pg. 4) for your and Archeoworks' review.

Good Afternoon Asha,

We appreciate the additional time to provide you with our comments being that this is a significant area and a large, complex study area.

While we understand the archaeologist's Stage 1 recommendations in this circumstance, we typically like to see a Stage 2 assessment to field test and confirm the level of disturbance in areas such as this. Areas known for the long term occupation by Indigenous communities, where there has been significant development of the area prior to the legislative need to have an archaeological assessment completed and because of this, only has a limited number of assessments completed to date to demonstrate and evaluate local conditions, and identify archaeological sites. This judgemental Stage 2 survey approach allows for an empirical evaluation of the conditions, as opposed to an educated observation based on surface conditions, background research and aerial photos. This approach, through its due diligence, helps to prevent unanticipated delays during construction from undocumented archaeological resources or human remains.

So that you are aware, there is record of a registered archaeological site within 1 km of the study area that has identified impacted Indigenous human remains, which demonstrates the presence of burials and habitation within this area.

To note, in this report in Section 3.3 Archeoworks does note that,

Disturbances consisting of, but not limited to, the paved roadways and curbs, grassed margins, cut slopes/artificial embankments, access driveways, bridge structures, landscaped residential frontages and utility installations, are found within the study corridor (*see Images 1-26*). The construction of these features would have resulted in severe damage to the integrity of any archaeological resources which may have been present within their footprints. However, these aforementioned areas of deep and extensive disturbances should only be considered as *likely* not requiring Stage 2 survey. Once project designs have been refined, a visual inspection and documentation during the Stage 2 AA is still required to provide on-site confirmation and documentation of the actual condition of areas to be impacted, prior to construction. (Pg. 16)

This statement reflects our concerns and would like to see this as the approach taken even though the report recommendations seem to omit these considerations.
