

## NOTICE OF ONLINE PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

### New Sanitary Sewer on Fair Birch Drive and Birchview Drive in the City of Mississauga

#### Background:

The Region of Peel has identified the need to replace the existing sanitary sewer that runs through rear-yard easements along the tributary of Lornewood Creek north of Fair Birch Drive. A Schedule 'B' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study was completed in August 2019, which identified the preferred alternative as the construction of a new sewer within existing road rights-of-way. Since that time, the design of the preferred solution has been advanced.

*Online public engagement* has been arranged to allow members of the public an opportunity to review the design of the proposed sanitary sewer on Birchview Drive and Fair Birch Drive. Information will be provided on how construction will be managed and how it will affect traffic and daily routines.
