News from the Province

The Ministry of Children and Youth Services (MCYS) recently conducted focus groups regarding proposed regulatory amendments to the [Day Nurseries Act](#). In March, MCYS representatives advised that based on feedback from many sources, there will be no changes to the regulations at this time. The feedback was clear and MCYS remains committed to quality standards as they move forward with future policy directions.

On February 17, 2010, the Ministry of Education [announced plans](#) to support the implementation of full-day early learning for four- and five-year olds by introducing the [Full-Day Early Learning Statute Law Amendment Act, 2010](#) which would amend the Education Act.

The Ministry of Children and Youth Services (MCYS) continues to request information to support the transition of children into the school system. In February, the Region's Purchase of Service Analysts completed the second stage impact assessment. Thank you for taking the time to collect and report the data!
