2nd Annual Community Expo to Offer Job and Volunteer Information for Newcomer Youth

March 2, 2010 – Mississauga, ON – Volunteer MBC (Mississauga, Brampton, Caledon) has partnered with the Youth Exchange Program to host their 2nd Annual Community Expo for youth. The Expo will offer informative presentations from community organizations such as Habitat for Humanity, ACCESS Charity, Service Canada and Volunteer MBC, followed by a volunteer and job fair with over 30 organizations participating.

The Community Expo will be held tomorrow, Wednesday, March 3, 2010 at the Holiday Inn, which is located at 30 Peel Centre Drive in Brampton. The presentations will take place from 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. with the volunteer and job fair being held until 6:00 p.m. Other partners of the Community Expo include Sheridan College, Employment Ontario, the Peel Halton Workforce Development Group, and the Brampton Mayor's Youth Team.

The Youth Exchange Program is a series of community activities and events targeted at youth who are new to Canada and their parents to help them connect to their new communities. The program is funded by the Citizenship and Immigration Canada and is coordinated by the Centre for Education and Training.

Volunteer MBC will be providing detailed information about youth volunteerism in their presentation at 1:30 p.m., as well as at their booth during the volunteer and job fair. In addition, the volunteer centre will be promoting the upcoming *ChangeTheWorld - Ontario Youth Volunteer Challenge*, which will be held from April 18 through to May 9, 2010. *The Challenge* is an initiative by the Ministry of Citizenship and Immigration, with over 20 volunteer centres across the province of Ontario participating.

"We truly feel that youth are the future of our community, and it is imperative for our volunteer centre to present the many benefits of youth volunteerism, especially for newcomer youth," stated Carine Strong, Executive Director of Volunteer MBC. "Volunteering is a great way to socially integrate, meet new friends, and to gain a better understanding of the role you can play in strengthening your community."
