Well, what can I say now except these comments: 1/I hope all members of Regional Council read the correspondence too because they bear legal and moral responsibility for matters related to Peel; 2/In spite of comments made by the Minister, Kathleen Wynne, it appears that there was NOT an opportunity provided by the Ontario Government to obtain Province-wide consultation with the general driving public BEFORE a decision was made to start this program; 3/Similarly, at the Region of Peel, there was NOT an opportunity for Peel public input on this initiative BEFORE Peel decided to participate. Some minor community input has been possible but ONLY AFTER we raised questions before and after the October 1 presentation by Albanese and company which was only a presentation for info to Council NOT to the public; 4/As for AMO, they only raised questions with MTO AFTER we raised our concerns and questions. The entire process by which this project has gone forward should cause ALL of us concerns about how the public is affected by decisions over which they have no control even when those decisions affect everyone. Thanks for having the courage to raise the questions we did. On this issue you have been both responsive and responsible. Joe
