That the request from the Police Services Board for an additional \$2.0 million to construct the Peel Regional Police Materials Management Centre as attached as Appendix I to the report of the Chief Financial Officer and Commissioner of Corporate Services dated June 8, 2010 titled "Construction of New Peel Regional Police Materials Management Centre Infrastructure Stimulus Funding Project 09-8340S", be approved:

And further that this additional amount be financed from the Development Charges Police Reserve Fund R3540, in the sum of \$1.195 million, and the Peel Regional Police Facility Reserve R2221, in the sum of \$0.805 million;

And further that Capital Project 09-8340S be amended accordingly.

REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

- Construction of a new Peel Police Materials Management Centre to house the Fleet Operations, Quartermaster Stores and Telecommunication Systems was approved under the Infrastructure Stimulus Fund Program
- The project will provide much needed functional space as well as meet future growth requirements
- The construction tender process is completed and the total project cost can be determined

DISCUSSION

1. Background

On May 28, 2010 the Peel Police Service Board considered a report from the Deputy Chief-Corporate Services dated April 22, 2010 and titled Construction of New Peel Regional Police Materials Management Centre Infrastructure Stimulus Funding Project 09-8340S' as shown in the appendix. The Peel Police Service Board adopted this report and passed a motion recommending that:

Subject to Regional Council approval, the Board approve funding for Infrastructure Stimulus Fund Project 09-8340S, for the construction of the new Peel Regional Materials Management Centre be increased from \$11,500,000 to \$13,500,000 to be financed from

the Development Charges Police Reserve R3540 (\$1,195,000) and the Facility Reserve R2221 (\$805,000), in order to ensure Peel Regional Police achieves program objectives and best value for Infrastructure Stimulus Fund Investment.

Regional staff reviewed this motion and supplementing documents and support the Peel Police Service Board recommendation.

2. Findings

Neither the scope nor the costs of this project were fully developed at the time of submitting the application for Infrastructure Stimulus Fund Grant, in April 2009. The project was fully developed and tendered. The bids submitted, indicated the need for additional funding since there is currently a significant demand in the market for such construction work and, the March 31, 2011 time constraint required for completion, have resulted in a premium added to contractors' bids.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Funding is available and was allocated for Peel Regional Police Facilities capital needs in the Development Charges Police Reserve Fund R3540 and the Peel Regional Police Facility Reserve R2221.

CONCLUSION

The Infrastructure Stimulus Fund offers an opportunity for significant investment and job creation to occur in the Region of Peel, and also allows for the development of new or retrofit of existing public infrastructure. It is recommended that the additional resources requested be approved to ensure the program objectives are achieved and the Region receives best value for its investment.

Subject to Regional Council approval, funding for Infrastructure Stimulus Fund project 09-8340S, for the construction of a new Peel Regional Police Materials Management centre be increased from \$11,500,000 to \$13,500,000 to be financed from Development Charges Police Reserve R3540 (\$1,195,000) and the Facility Reserve R2221 (\$805,000), in order to ensure Peel Regional Police achieves program objectives and best value for Infrastructure Stimulus Funding investment;

REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

- Construction of a new Peel Regional Police Materials Management Centre to house Fleet Operations, Quartermaster Stores, and Telecommunications Systems and Services (TSS) radio installation was approved under the Infrastructure Stimulus Funding (ISF) program and will provide much needed functional space as well as meet future growth requirements.
- The scope of the project and costs were not completely developed at the time of the funding application but are now known.
- The construction tender process is complete and the total project costs can be calculated.
