**REPORT HIGHLIGHTS**

- The review of the external funding assistance received during 2010 showed a total of \$7,138,672.48 in funding relating to eleven grant programs, ten external secondments and two other initiatives.

**DISCUSSION**

**1. Background**

The Peel Police Services Board policy, External Funding Assistance – Public Police Programs, and FIN-900: External Funding Assistance for Investigations and Public Police Programs require external funding assistance of \$25,000 or more received for public police programs be reported to the Police Services Board annually. In addition, the Chief of Police is to report to the Board, on an exception basis, any external funding requests that he believes should be brought to the Board's immediate attention, including those programs or projects that may generate general public interest or response.

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## 2. Findings

The review of external funding assistance received during 2010 showed a total of \$7,138,672.48 in funding relating to eleven grant programs, ten external secondments and two other initiatives. The following is a listing of actual external funding assistance received from external agencies during the period January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010:

#### **Community Policing Partnership Grant**

Funding for salary and benefits of 124 front-line officers from the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services.

#### **Safer Communities One Thousand Officers Grant**

Funding toward salary and benefits of 97 officers from the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services.

#### **Police Officers Recruitment Fund**

Funding for salary and benefits associated with 13 new officers from the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services.

August 2010 (for period April 1, 2010 to March 31, 2011) \$ 910,000.00

#### **Provincial Anti-Violence Intervention Strategy – Guns and Gangs**

Funding for specialized rapid response teams to suppress gun and gang violence and crack down on illegal drug operations from the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services.

May 2010 (for period October 1, 2009 to March 31, 2010) \$ 544,000.00

#### **Firearms Grant**

Funding towards the costs of operating an office to assist citizens in complying with the national firearms registry.

#### **Provincial Strategy to Protect Children from Sexual Abuse and Exploitation on the Internet**

Funding towards the implementation of the Provincial Strategy to prevent the sexual abuse and exploitation of children via the Internet from the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services.


