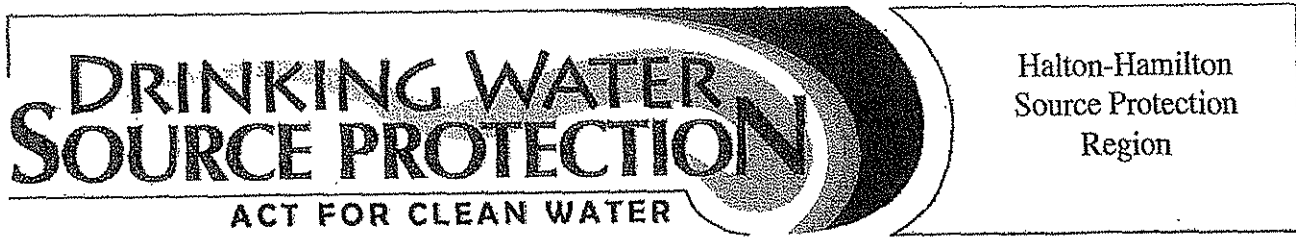

**Re: Notice of drinking water threat policies to be implemented by the Region of Peel**

We are writing to notify you that the Halton-Hamilton Source Protection Committee, has begun preparation of the Source Protection Plan to protect the municipal drinking water sources in your area. The Plan will include policies that will address existing and potential future significant threats to the drinking water sources. These policies will apply to a small portion of the Region of Peel that is located within the Halton Region Conservation Authority watershed (see attached figure). This letter serves as a notice for the purposes of Ontario Regulation 287/07 made under the Ontario Clean Water Act, 2006.

You are receiving this notice because your municipality will be responsible for implementing a number of the proposed Source Protection Plan policies.

Policies have been drafted that are strategic in nature to enhance protection of the drinking water sources across the watershed. Attached to this letter are the policy summary sheets that are applicable to the Region of Peel and that set out the rationale and the proposed policy.

Background information reviewed by the Source Protection Committee and a summary of the discussion that occurred on development of these policies are included in the Background Report for the Halton Region Source Protection Area. This report can be reviewed on our website at [www.protectingwater.ca](http://www.protectingwater.ca).

This is your first opportunity to provide comments on the proposed policies. We would like you to review these policies to ensure they are feasible and implementable before they are presented to the public. In February 2012, the Committee will be posting a draft proposed Source Protection Plan on our website for public review and comment. We will be providing you a notice of that posting and you will be able to provide comments again at that time. Further, the proposed Source Protection Plan will be released in June 2012 for a final round of public consultation before being submitted to the Minister of the Environment for review and approval.


