On behalf of the nine Conservation Authorities of the Conservation Authorities Moraine Coalition (CAMC), I am pleased to enclose two brochures detailing our efforts and successes on the Oak Ridges Moraine in 2011.

The mission of the CAMC is to advance the science for understanding the Oak Ridges Moraine, leading to broad support for the conservation and protection of the form, function and linkages of the moraine. We have formed numerous partnerships to:

- undertake groundwater, watershed and natural heritage system studies;
- enhance the moraine through a variety of land stewardship programs and projects; and
- provide education, recreation and conservation opportunities on the moraine through land securement initiatives and by supporting an accessible trail system.

2011 also marked the 10th anniversary of the CAMC partnership with the Regional Municipalities of York, Peel and Durham and the City of Toronto (YPDT), to understand, manage and protect the groundwater resources of the Oak Ridges Moraine and related aquifers. A separate brochure to identify the benefits and successes of this program has also been included.

I would like to take this opportunity to extend thanks to all our partners for their contributions to CAMC's work in protecting and enhancing the Oak Ridges Moraine.
