RECOMMENDATION

That the encroachment on Regional Road 7 (Queen Street) being a pylon sign with a concrete base, located at the south east corner of Queen Street East and McVean Drive, City of Brampton, be permitted in accordance with the terms and conditions in the Encroachment Agreement dated March 1, 2012, between the Regional Municipality of Peel and the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority;

And further, that the necessary by-law be presented for enactment.

REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

Regional Council approval is required to enter into an Encroachment Agreement between The Regional Municipality of Peel and the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority to allow a pylon sign within the widened limits of Regional Road 7.

DISCUSSION

The Toronto and Region Conservation Authority is the owner of property known municipally as The Claireville Conservation Area in the City of Brampton, being located on the south side of Queen Street between Goreway Drive and The Gore Road.

The owner is proposing to install a new entry sign with a concrete base for The Claireville Conservation area. The Owner has requested the Region to permit the sign to encroach upon the widened limits of Queen Street.

A signed Encroachment Agreement has been received from the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority. The term of the Encroachment Agreement is 20 years commencing on January 1, 2012 and terminating on December 31, 2031.
