### **What is Student Led DPA?**

Peel Public Health is offering a new program where Grade 5's are trained to be DPA Student Leaders in their school:

- Two DPA Student Leaders will visit a classroom to lead the 20 minute segment or be involved in other forms of DPA (e.g., leading DPA at an assembly).
- Teacher supervision is required during student led DPA.

### **Benefits of Student Led DPA:**

- Provides leadership opportunity for students
- Allows students to develop skills in organization, communication and problem solving
- Supports teachers in meeting the goals of DPA
- Provides variety in the DPA schedule

### **Student Led DPA Training will include:**

- Leadership development
- Communication skills
- Introduction to DPA activities and resources
- Planning and delivery of DPA activities
