

## Common Reasons for an Incomplete Record

If you have updated this student's immunization record and are unsure why the record is still incomplete, please answer the questions below for common reasons. If you answered 'no' to any of the questions below and still do not know why this student's record is incomplete, please call Peel Public Health at 905-799-7700.

<b>1.</b> Did this student receive the first MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) vaccine before the age of one?	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>2.</b> Did this student receive the second dose of MMR less than 28 days after the first dose of MMR vaccine?	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>

<p>Certain types of vaccine, for example, measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) and chickenpox (varicella) must be given on the same day, or at least 28 days apart, or this student may not develop immunity for the second vaccine given (in this case the MMR vaccine).</p> <p><b>Action Required:</b> If you answered yes to any of the above questions, this student will need additional doses of the MMR vaccine.</p>

<p>Your doctor does not report immunizations to Peel Public Health. The school only forwards immunization records to Peel Public Health at the time of initial school registration.</p> <p><b>Action Required:</b> If you answered yes, we still don't have a complete record of this student's immunization. *According to the Immunization of School Pupils Act, Ontario students under 18 years of age must provide proof of immunization against diphtheria, tetanus, polio, measles, mumps and rubella or a valid exemption to attend school.*
