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MMR II Vaccine and Reported Adverse Events

The Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) has notified Public Health Units of three lots of MMR II vaccine, temporarily suspended pending investigation of a cluster of adverse reactions reported in Alberta. The affected lot numbers are **1528U**, **1529U** and **1680U**.

None of the affected lots of vaccine was distributed by Public Health Units in Ontario.

Merck Frosst, the manufacturer of MMR II, has indicated that a small quantity of the vaccine was purchased privately in Ontario and distributed to several hospitals and army bases. Merck Frosst is notifying these purchasers.
