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Influenza Vaccine Distribution

During the 2005/2006 Universal Influenza Campaign Peel Public Health distributed 385,472 doses of influenza vaccine to Peel area physicians, workplaces, nursing agencies, long term care facilities, hospitals and community clinics.

Peel Health administered 21,492 flu shots at 72 community clinic locations throughout the Region.

- This order form must be completed and sent back to Peel Public Health by September 29th, 2006. Please fax to (905) 793-2114.
- For your convenience, the vaccine order form indicates the number of doses of influenza vaccine your office used in 2005/2006. Please use this as a guide to estimate the number of doses of influenza vaccine you will need this year.
- The first allotment of influenza vaccine each physician's office will receive will be a fair distribution of vaccine received by Peel Public Health from the Ministry of Health.
- Please remember to select a pick-up location at the top of the order form.

Vaccine Storage

- Influenza vaccine must be stored within the temperature range of + 2°C and +8°C. All vaccine storage and handling guidelines must be applied.
