

# This year it's a different flu season!

## The H1N1 vaccine is your best protection. You should get it.

- H1N1 vaccine is available for everyone 6 months of age and older.
- You can get your vaccine at Peel Public Health clinics.
- If you think you might have the flu, wait until you are better to get vaccinated.
- Pregnant women and children 6 months to 1 year of age must see a doctor to get the H1N1 vaccine.
- Children 6 months to 9 years of age will require 2 vaccinations. There must be at least 21 days between the first and second vaccine.
- The H1N1 vaccine is FREE.

### Peel Public Health Early H1N1 Vaccine Clinics

Early clinics are directed especially to residents under 65 years of age with chronic medical conditions (asthma, diabetes, heart, lung or kidney disease or those receiving treatments for cancer or other illnesses that might affect the immune system) and their caregivers.
