





## Magnified Bacteria and What They Do!

Name of Bacteria	What it Looks Like	Where it is Found	What it Does!
Escherichia coli		In the stomachs of humans and animals, (especially cattle)	Commonly causes diarrhea, vomiting and stomach cramps. Can have serious complications.
Staphylococcus aureus		On human skin, in nose and throat	Commonly causes skin and wound infections. Also causes pimples.
Salmonella enteritidis		In the stomachs of humans and animals, (especially chicken)	Causes diarrhea and vomiting. One of the most common causes of food poisoning.
Streptococcus pyogenes		In the throat and nose of humans	Very common cause of sore throats. Can also cause skin infections.
