Downtown Brampton

Peel Region's **Chapelview Housing Development** is a new 200-unit residence and parking garage built in the City of Brampton. Owned by the Region of Peel, the development is funded through a partnership with the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation, the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing, the City of Brampton and the Region of Peel. The building provides affordable, mixed-income rental units for seniors and singles and is scheduled for completion in fall 2009. The underground parking garage will be owned and operated by the City of Brampton.

Chapelview has been designed with the architectural flavour of the local downtown Brampton community in mind.

Located at 16 John St. in Brampton, the residence features one and two bedroom units for seniors and singles. Four apartments will be fully accessible.

March 2008 Construction Update

Since our last local community update significant work has taken place on-site.

Large crane delivery to the site took place during December 2007 and we are currently in our 11th month of construction. The columns and foundation walls for the 6th and lowest level of underground parking garage have been completed. One-quarter of the slab work for level P5 has also been completed to date.



If our construction schedule continues smoothly, we anticipate completion of one level of underground garage per month.

Regional Council approved the name 'Chapelview' for the new project in October 2007.

Based on our construction progress; our anticipated date of completion is September 2009.
