

APARTMENT COLLECTION SERVICES

Approximately 82,000 multi-residential units, such as apartments, condominiums and town homes make up 30 per cent of the Region's households and are an integral component of Peel's recycling program. We count on your participation and support to further reduce the waste we generate in Peel.

No matter where you live in the Region of Peel, recycling services are available to you. If you are unsure of your recycling collection set-out area, contact your property manager or superintendent for details.

You may refer to this guide for a list of all items that can be recycled in your building's program (pages 10 and 11), as well as learn about additional disposal, recycling and reuse options available through Peel's Community Recycling Centres (pages 14 – 19).

Participating in our recycling program is now easier. You can mix all your recyclable material in one recycling cart, saving you time and effort!



How the Program Works

Multi-residential buildings are supplied with recycling carts. Each multi-residential unit is provided with a reusable Blue Bag to help store and transport recyclable material to your recycling collection set-out area.

Blue Bags are available at no charge. If you do not have one, please contact your property manager or superintendent.



Specialty Collection Services

The Region of Peel provides specialty collection services including:

- Christmas tree collection
- Furniture and large item collection
- Large metal appliance and fixture collection (fees apply - see page 4)

Contact your property manager or superintendent for more information on where to place these items for collection.



Items Not Collected

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)
