

# ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

## **NEW** – *Recycling information*

**Don't forget...** since April 5, 2010, select electronics (listed below) are no longer collected as garbage at the curb or from apartment buildings. Drop off used electronics at any Community Recycling Centre (CRC), **FREE OF CHARGE.**

Dropping off electronics at a CRC ensures any hazardous materials are safely removed and disposed of, and that the remaining components are recycled.

The electronics listed below may also be taken to participating retailers. Visit [dowhatyoucan.ca](http://dowhatyoucan.ca), choose "electronics" and search for the nearest collection site by municipality, postal code or material type.

***The following items will not be collected. Bring them to your local CRC or participating retailer for recycling, free of charge.***

- > telephones and accessories
- > cellular phones
- > PDAs and pagers
- > audio and video players
- > cameras
- > equalizers, (pre)amplifiers

- > video players/projectors
- > video recorders
- > personal handheld computers
