Aluminum cans



Glass and plastic bottles
(place caps in garbage)



Paper bags and non-resealable plastic bags
(multiple plastic bags in one tied plastic bag only)



Cardboard food holders



Polystyrene foam packaging



Aluminum plates and trays
No foil wrap



Plastic tubs and lids
Remove lids and place in recycling container



Notebook paper
(not shredded)



Please make sure all containers are emptied and rinsed before placing them in the recycling containers.
