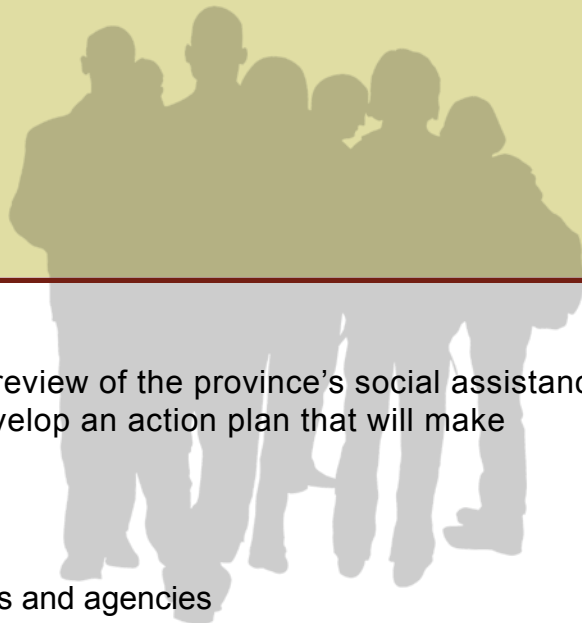


# Peel's Community Forum for the Social Assistance Review
