Crocus	<i>Crocus species</i>	10 cm to 20 cm (4 in to 8 in)	Sun	March to April	Early spring
Foxtail Lily	<i>Eremurus</i>	90 cm to 120 cm (3 ft to 4 ft)	Sun	May to June	Likes dry location
Winter Aconite	<i>Eranthis</i>	8 cm to 10 cm (3 in to 4 in)	Sun	March to April	Multiplies
Fritillaria	<i>Fritillaria species</i>	30 cm (12 in)	Sun	May	Lovely checkered blossom
Snowdrop	<i>Galanthus species</i>	10 cm to 15 cm (4 in to 6 in)	Sun	March to April	White flower
Daylily	<i>Hemerocallis species</i>	30 cm to 90 cm (12 in to 36 in)	Sun to shade	July to August	Spreads easily
Iris	<i>Iris germanica species</i>	60 cm to 90 cm (24 in to 36 in)	Full sun	June to July	Many colours
Grape Hyacinth	<i>Muscari</i>	30 cm (12 in)	Full sun to partial shade	May	Sweet smell
Daffodil, Narcissus, Jonquil	<i>Narcissus species</i>	30 to 60 cm (12 to 24 in)	Sun to partial shade	April to May	Many varieties
Tulips	<i>Tulipa species</i>	10 to 30 cm (4 in to 12 in)	Sun to partial shade	Mid April to May	Many varieties
