

Floods Happen. Protect Your Home.

Step 1: Maintain what you've got at least twice per year





 Remove debris from nearest storm drain or ditch and culvert.




Clean out eaves troughs.



3 Check for leaks in plumbing, fixtures and appliances.




4 Test your sump pump.




5 Clean out your backwater valve.

Step 2: Complete simple upgrades






1 Install window well covers (where fire escape requirements permit).




Extend downspouts and sump discharge pipes at least 2 m from foundation.



Store valuables and hazardous materials in watertight containers and secure fuel tanks.




Remove obstructions to floor drain.



5 Install and maintain flood alarm.
