

What to do after being tested



Stay at home.

It's important to self-isolate at home while you're waiting for results to avoid spreading the virus. If you had symptoms when you were tested, the people you live with must also stay home while you wait for your test results.



Answer the call.

If your test is positive, the Region of Peel Public Health will call you to go over test results. Answering the questions from public health staff helps keep you, your family and community safe.



Protect those at home.

If you develop symptoms or had symptoms when you got tested, distance from those you live with. If possible, stay in your own room, do not share bathrooms, wear a mask, physically distance and wash your hands often.
