Dear Honourable Chair Dale:

As a life-long resident of Caledon, and a business owner in Cheltenham, I am truly dismayed that the vocal minority has caused such delay and confusion surrounding the decision to build a small parking lot in the name of public safety.

The temporary closure of the Cheltenham Badlands will not only cause confusion amongst tourists travelling through Caledon, but it will most definitely cause a downturn in the seasonal revenues many of our shops, markets, and restaurants depend on, including ours. Our business relies on tourist traffic in order to be sustainable.

Having lived within a few kilometers of the site for many years, I can assure you that a parking lot is a must as the volume of people visiting the site has created unsafe traffic situations for visitors and locals. It really is a matter of WHEN will someone be hurt, not IF. Now with the site closed, we've experienced groups of people standing in the middle of the road trying to figure out what to do next as the Badlands was their destination.

I am not able to attend the council meeting on June 11th, 2015 but I would respectfully request that my correspondence be added to the agenda. I believe that the parking situation on Olde Base Line Road must be addressed and I believe that a parking lot on Olde Base Line Road is the first logical step to that process.
