Consultation on the CTC Draft Proposed Source Protection Plan Pursuant to the Clean Water Act, 2006, and Ontario Regulation 287/07

Public Consultation on the CTC Draft Proposed Source Protection Plan is scheduled for March 19 to May 1, 2012. You are receiving this notice as all or part of your municipality is located within the CTC Source Protection Region, which is comprised of the following Source Protection Areas: Credit Valley, Toronto and Region, and Central Lake Ontario.

The Source Protection Plan

Under the Clean Water Act, 2006, the CTC Source Protection Committee (SPC) must develop policies which address significant drinking water threats. The Source Protection Committee must consult with municipalities on the CTC Draft Proposed Source Protection Plan.

Please find enclosed paper and digital copies of the CTC Draft Proposed Source Protection Plan. Also included are high resolution versions of all the maps (digital) found within the Source Protection Plan and the Explanatory Document (digital). The Explanatory Document provides the rationale behind the policy development and a summary of how the comments received during pre-consultation (October to December 2011) were considered. If you have any questions, please contact CTC staff noted below. Comments on the Draft Proposed Source Protection Plan can be submitted by staff or through Council resolution (a Council resolution is not mandatory). All comments should be submitted to my attention and must be considered by the SPC in revising the policies

Public Consultation

The first period of public consultation is scheduled between March 19 and May 1, 2012. Seven Open Houses are scheduled within the CTC Source Protection Region, and are being advertised in regional and local newspapers, online at the CTC website, direct mail to affected landowners and via email to other stakeholders. Attached are copies of newspaper advertisements.

The Proposed Source Protection Plan will be posted for a second period of public consultation for 30 days in June-July, 2012. The CTC Proposed Source Protection Plan will be submitted to the Minister of Environment on August 20, 2012, along with any comments received from the second public consultation and resolutions from Councils.


