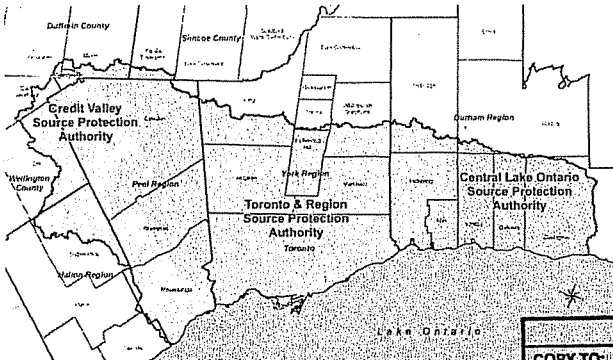

FINAL Consultation on the CTC Proposed Source Protection Plan
Pursuant to the *Clean Water Act, 2006*, and *Ontario Regulation 287/07*

Final Public Consultation on the CTC Proposed Source Protection Plan is scheduled for September 7th through October 8th, 2012. You are receiving this notice as all or part of your municipality is located within the CTC Source Protection Region, which is comprised of the following Source Protection Areas: Credit Valley, Toronto and Region, and Central Lake Ontario.

The Source Protection Plan

Under the *Clean Water Act, 2006*, the CTC Source Protection Committee (SPC) must develop policies which address significant drinking water threat activities which are or could be present in vulnerable areas around municipal drinking water supplies. The SPC may also develop policies to address low and moderate drinking water threats. These areas and the threats have been identified in the previously prepared and provincially approved Assessment Report for each Source Protection Area.

Public Consultation

The respective Source Protection Authorities must now consult with municipalities, other implementing bodies and persons who commented previously on the CTC Draft Proposed Source Protection Plan during the first public consultation (March 19 to May 1, 2012). The second period of public consultation is scheduled for September 7th through October 8th, 2012.

Please find enclosed digital copies of the CTC Proposed Source Protection Plan. Also included are high resolution versions of the maps where policies may apply and the Explanatory Document. The Explanatory Document provides the rationale behind the policy development and a summary of how the comments received during the first public consultation were considered by the CTC SPC. 
