Alcohol Poisoning

- Remember that alcohol is a depressant. That means it slows things down in the brain and body, like breathing.
- If someone drinks too much it can lead to alcohol poisoning. Turn them on their side (recovery position) and call for help.
- Remember you only need to see one of these signs to call 911: won't wake up, vomits while asleep, has slow breathing or pulse, has cold, pale or bluish skin

● It is illegal to:

- Drink or buy alcohol under the age of 19
- To be given alcohol under the age of 19
- Drive a car after drinking alcohol
- Drink alcohol in public places like parks and parking lots etc.

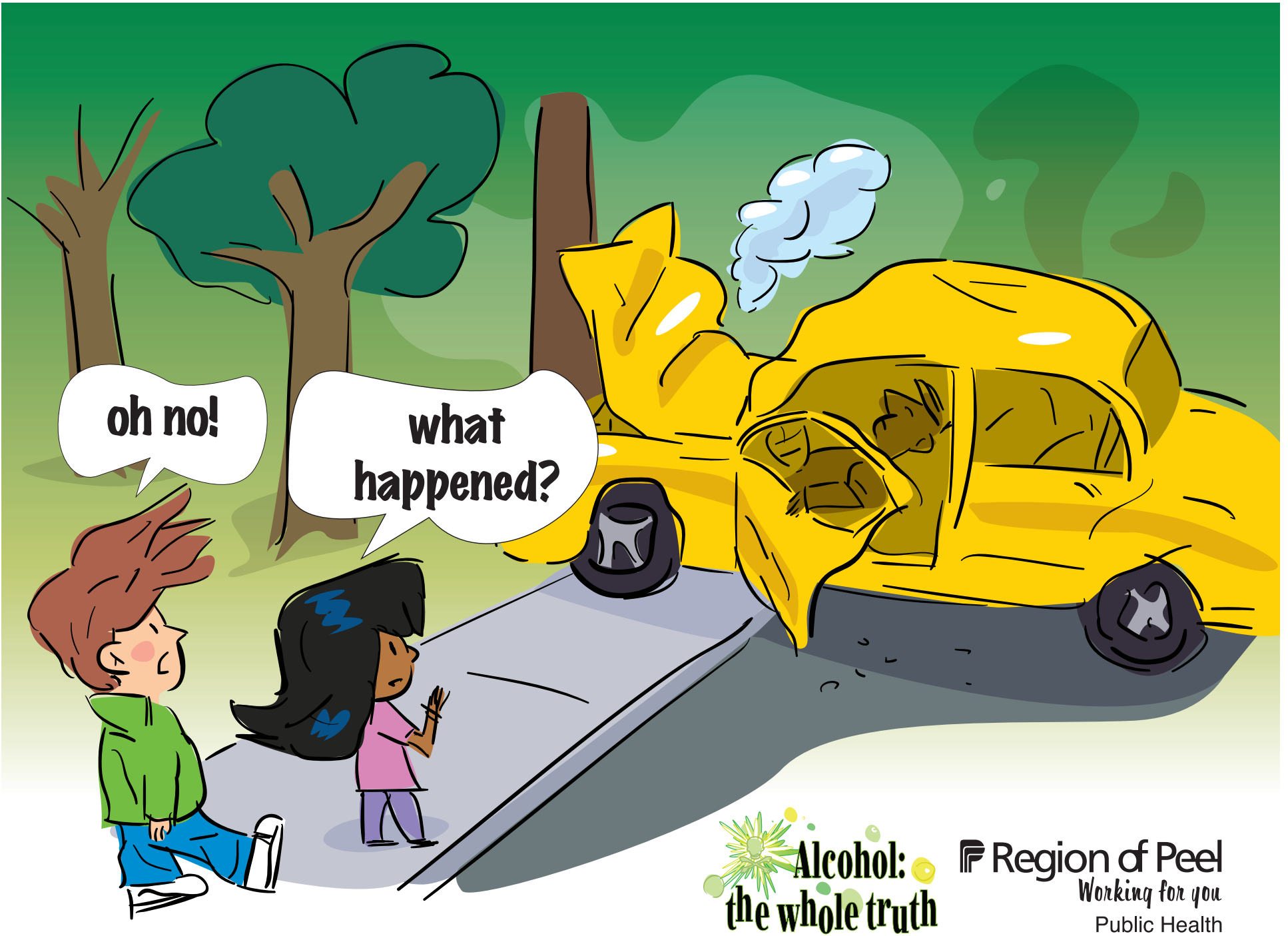
