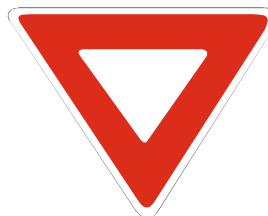


Activity #3 – Road Signs

On the left side of the page are signs you are likely to see along your streets.

Match the correct description from the right side with the correct sign on the left side



YIELD:
Let other traffic go first.

PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK:
Cyclists must stop and let pedestrians cross the street.

STOP:
Stop and look in all directions. Ride only when it is safe to do so.

ONE WAY:
Ride only in the direction that the arrow points.

NO PEDESTRIANS OR BICYCLES ALLOWED:
Cyclists and pedestrians should not be on these roads.

RAILWAY CROSSING:
Obey railway signals. Stop and walk your bike across the tracks.

THREE LIGHT SIGNAL:
Green means go, amber means prepare to stop and red means stop.
