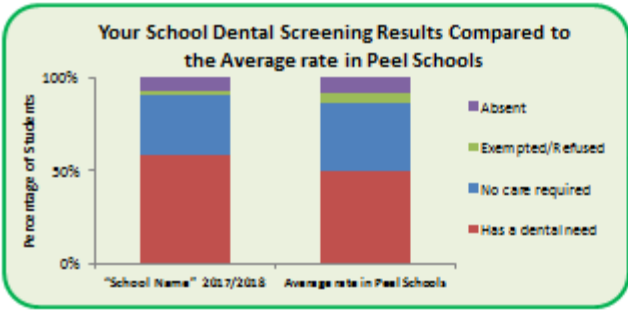

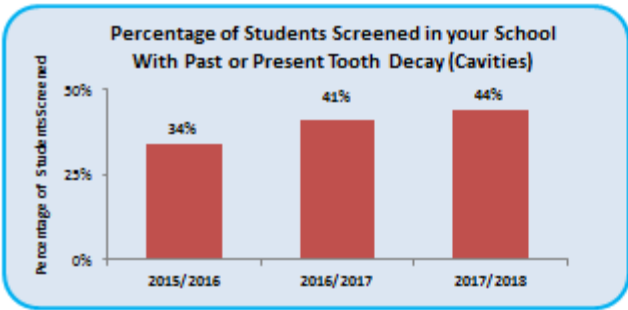

See your school's oral health results compared to the Average rate in Peel Schools.



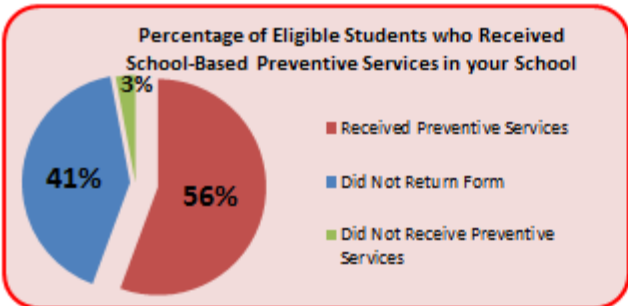
Your school has a **higher rate of students who have a dental need** compared to Peel Schools
