

Tobacco Sales Prohibition (Automatic Prohibition)

The Region of Peel - Public Health inspects tobacco retailers for compliance with the Smoke-Free Ontario Act.

If the owner of a tobacco retail location in Peel Region is convicted of a tobacco sales offence at that retail location, and if that owner, or a previous owner was convicted of a separate tobacco sales offence at the same address, within the preceding five years, the Region of Peel - Public Health will request a “*Notice of Prohibition Against the Sale, Supply, Storage and Delivery*” (also known as an “Automatic Prohibition (AP)”) from the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care. If granted, this Notice would prevent the retail location from being able to sell, supply or store tobacco on site for a defined period of time.

The following businesses have received an Automatic Prohibition (AP) since April 1, 2018 under the Smoke-Free Ontario Act.
