Construction of the new Seniors Health and Wellness Village at Peel Manor is progressing well! The new building will be located at 525 Main St. N., Brampton using part of Murray Street Park. Once complete, the old building will be removed and replaced with a new, revitalized park space. The new building will include a long-term care centre, expanded Adult Day Services and a service hub. The hub will include community spaces and health and social services.

Murray St. Park playground gets a **modern makeover**

We are very excited to announce that the new Murray Street Neighbourhood Park will be open to the community October 31, 2020! The Region of Peel and City of Brampton (Open Space Development) partnered to redevelop the park area to create a more engaging and exciting space for our community to enjoy.

As part of the neighbourhood park enhancement, amenities include new modern junior and senior accessible playground components, seating options, a covered shade structure, more trees and shrub beds, a pedestrian pathway system and lighting for better safety.

Returning this amenity to our neighborhood residents (particularly the little ones!) is a priority, and we are pleased that it will be reopened for play.



Construction update

Construction has continued throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. While the pandemic has impacted construction in various ways, the Region of Peel and Buttcon have put measures in place that have allowed construction to continue. Safety remains the top priority onsite. Added measures were put in place to help protect workers from COVID-19.



You may have seen more weekend activity on the site. This is because the contractor is working to make up for lost time caused by COVID-19 related staffing and supply issues. This will likely continue for the foreseeable future.

It has been amazing to see the building begin to take shape. Installing services on the site also continues. This includes running storm and sanitary sewer systems across the Manorbridge property, which is almost complete.

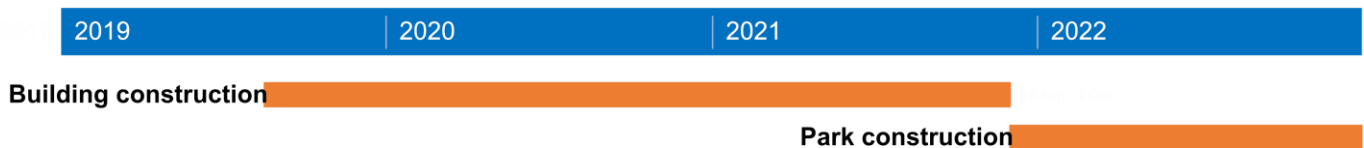
Feature spotlight: **Parking**

Construction **timeline**

Construction on the Seniors Health and Wellness Village at Peel Manor building is planned to last until the end of 2021. After our residents move into the new building, we will demolish the old Peel Manor building to make way for a new, revitalized park space. The park is expected to be completed by the end of 2022.
