## First Quarter 2018

### Quarterly Average Changes

#### Working Age Population

(persons who are in the working age group: 15+ years)



**+3.1%**

Up by 40,500 persons

#### Labour Force

(persons who are able to work and are looking for work)



**+4.7%**

Up by 39,400 persons

#### Employed Labour Force

(persons who are working)



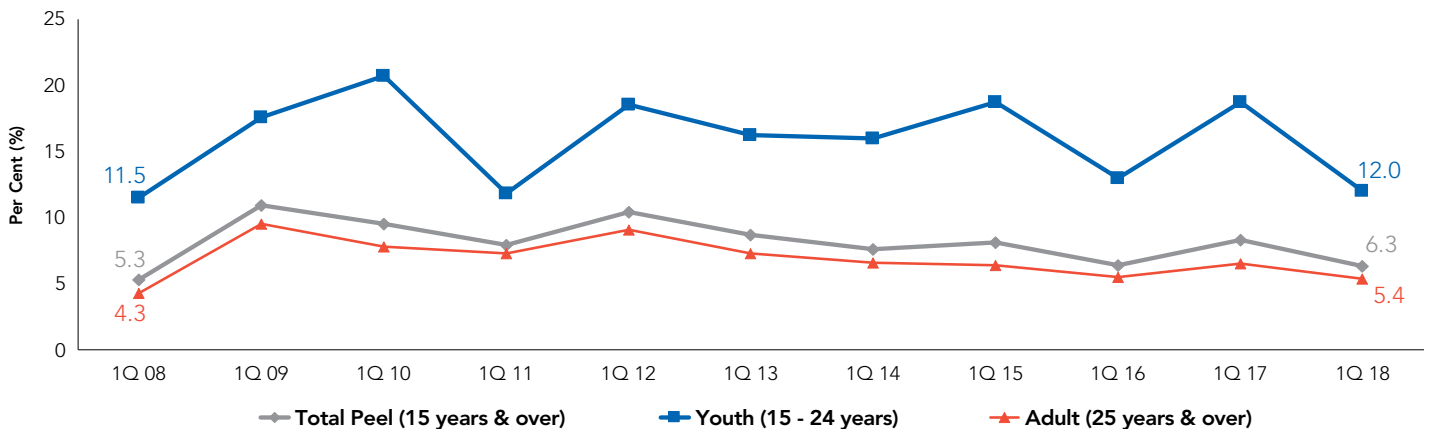
**+7.0%**

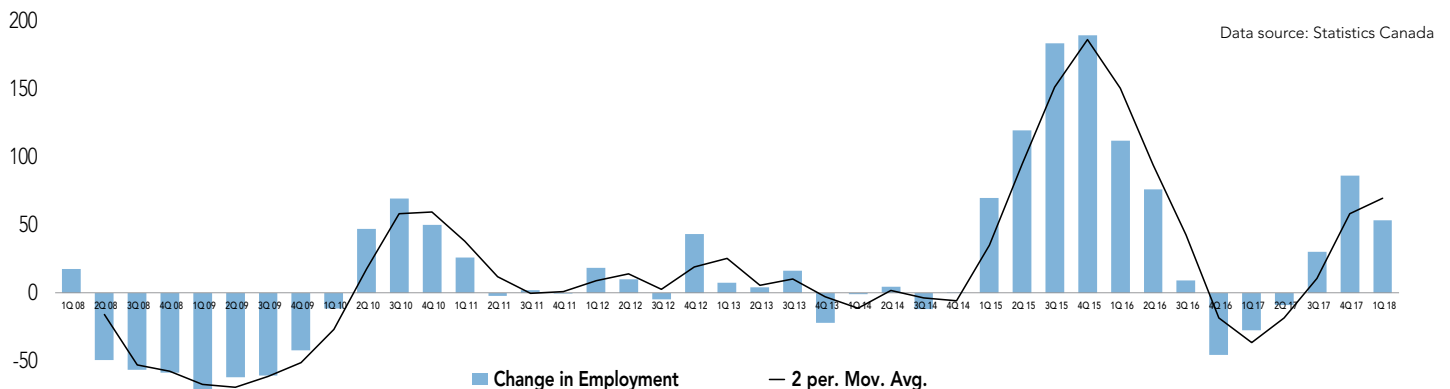
- **Positive labour market changes in Peel continues**

### Quarterly Average Unemployment Rate in Peel Declined in First Quarter 2018



- **Peel's unemployment rate is at its lowest level since first quarter of 2008**

### Change in Quarterly Average Employment in Peel (in thousands): 2008 – 2018



- **Q1 2018 marked the third consecutive increase in quarterly average employment in Peel's labour market**

## Sectoral Changes in Quarterly Average Employment by Major Industries

### Goods Producing Industries

Total: 149,400 persons -13.9%



Manufacturing: **-26.7%**

Construction: **+43.3%**

### Services Industries

Total: 669,600 persons +13.1%



Trade: **+10.6%**

Transportation and Warehousing: **+33.9%**

- Short-term sectorial shifts remain consistent with the long-term trends

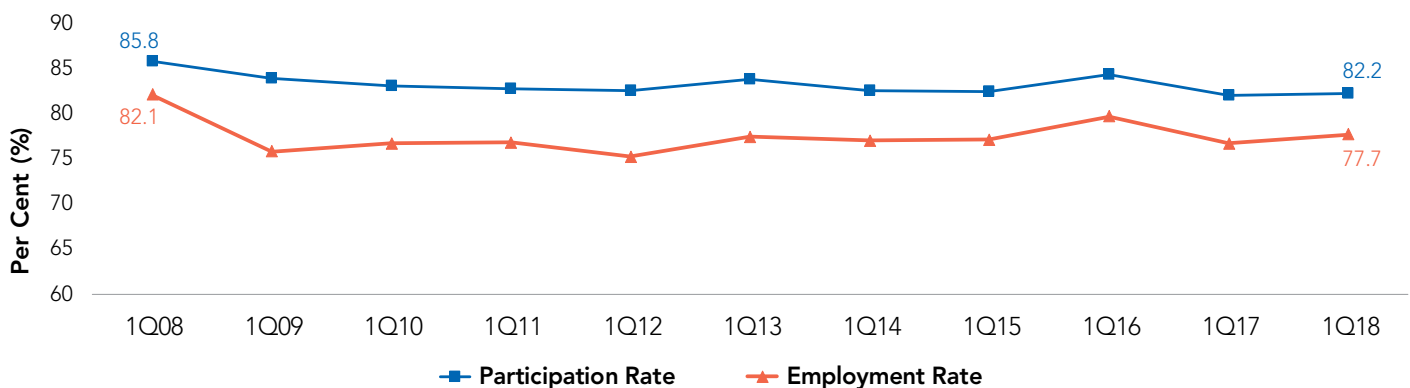

## Unemployment Rate By Age

Age Groups	Unemployment Rate	Year Over Year Change (in percentage points)
15-64	6.4%	-1.9
25-64	5.4%	-1.0
20-24	10.1%	-3.6
15-19	15.5%	-14.0

- Growth continued to be led by part-time employment
- Unemployment rate lower in all age groups

## Participation and Employment Rates in Peel for Core Group (25 – 64 Years)



- Employment and participation rates for the core working age residents remain relatively high
