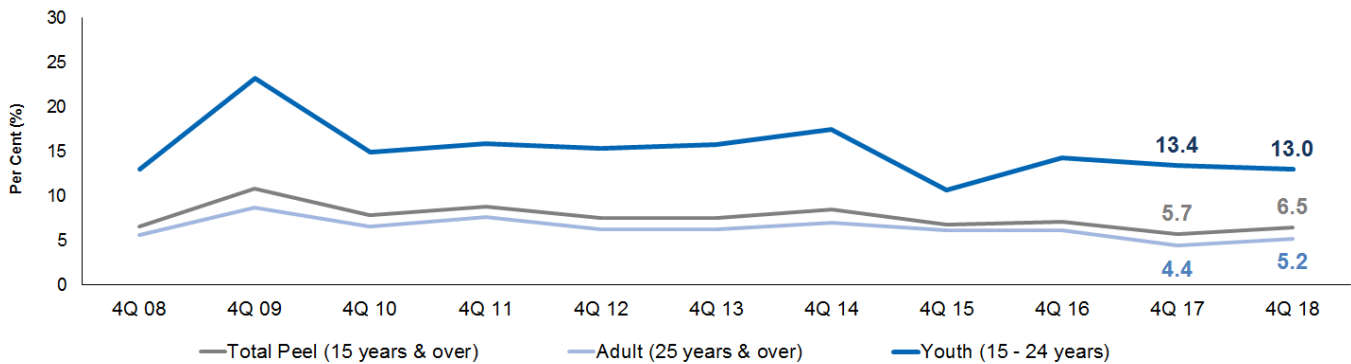

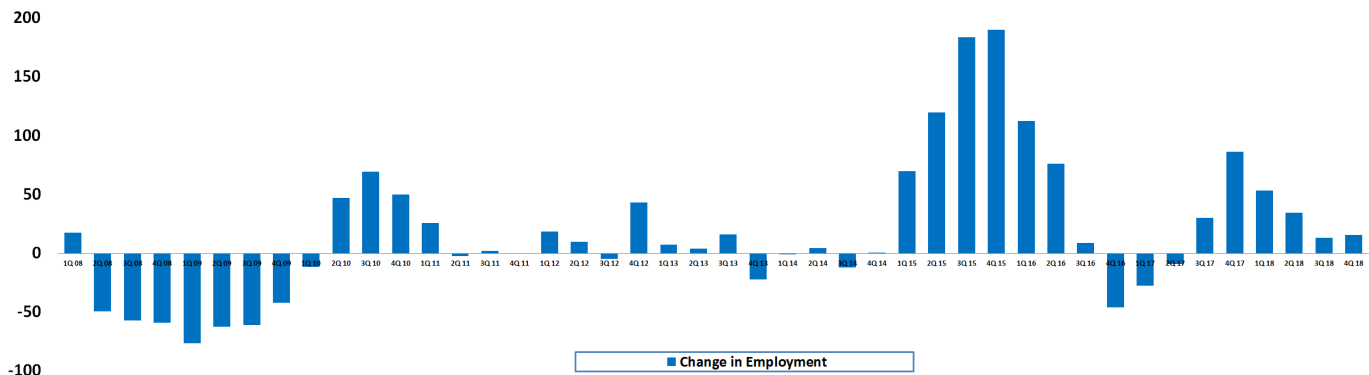
- Peel's labour market registered another positive change in key labour market indicators in Q4 2018.

Peel's Quarterly Average Unemployment Rates



- Peel's quarterly average labour force grew at a faster pace than the growth in quarterly average employment, leading to the overall quarterly average unemployment rate increasing by 0.8 percentage point between Q4 2017 and Q4 2018.

Changes in Quarterly Average Employment in Peel (in thousands): 2008 – 2018



- Peel's quarterly average employment registered it's sixth consecutive quarterly growth in Q4 2018.
