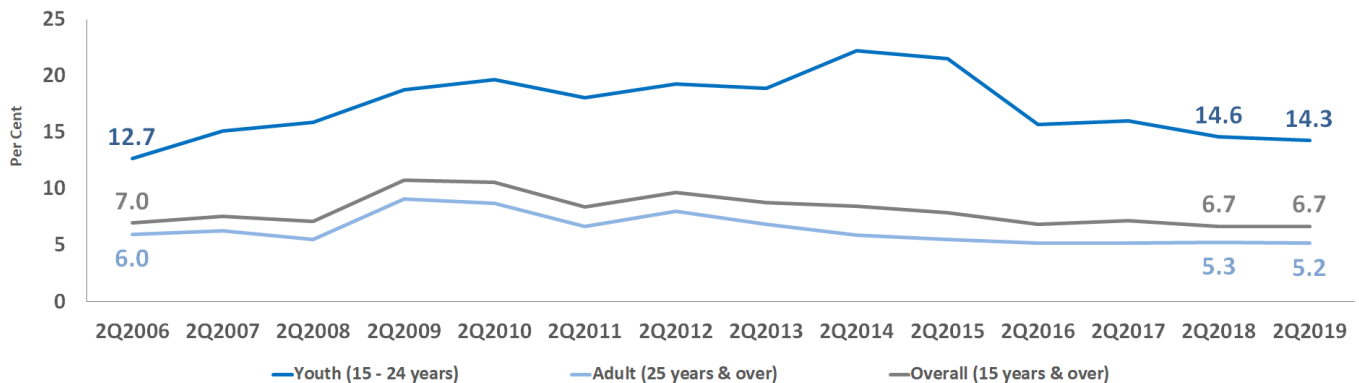

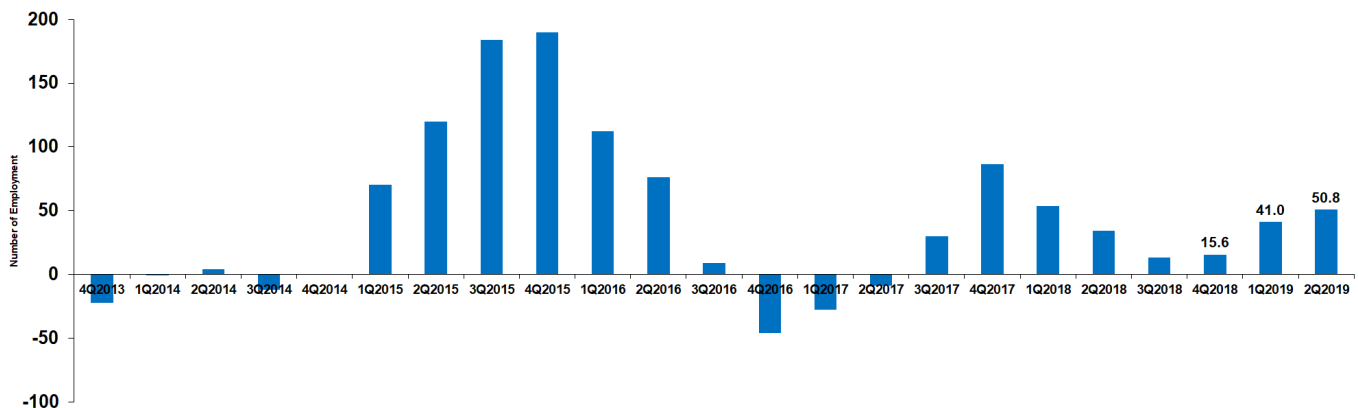
Total labour force and employment continued to increase in Q2 2019.

Peel's Quarterly Average Unemployment Rates



When compared with Q2 2018, the unemployment rate remained unchanged at 6.7 per cent in Q2 2019, as both labour force and employment grew at the same pace (6.1 per cent).

Changes in Quarterly Average Employment in Peel (in thousands): 2012 – 2019



Growth in Q2 2019 marked the eighth consecutive quarterly increase in Peel's quarterly average employment.
