The number of persons looking for work grew at an annualized rate of 1.5% or 12,900 persons

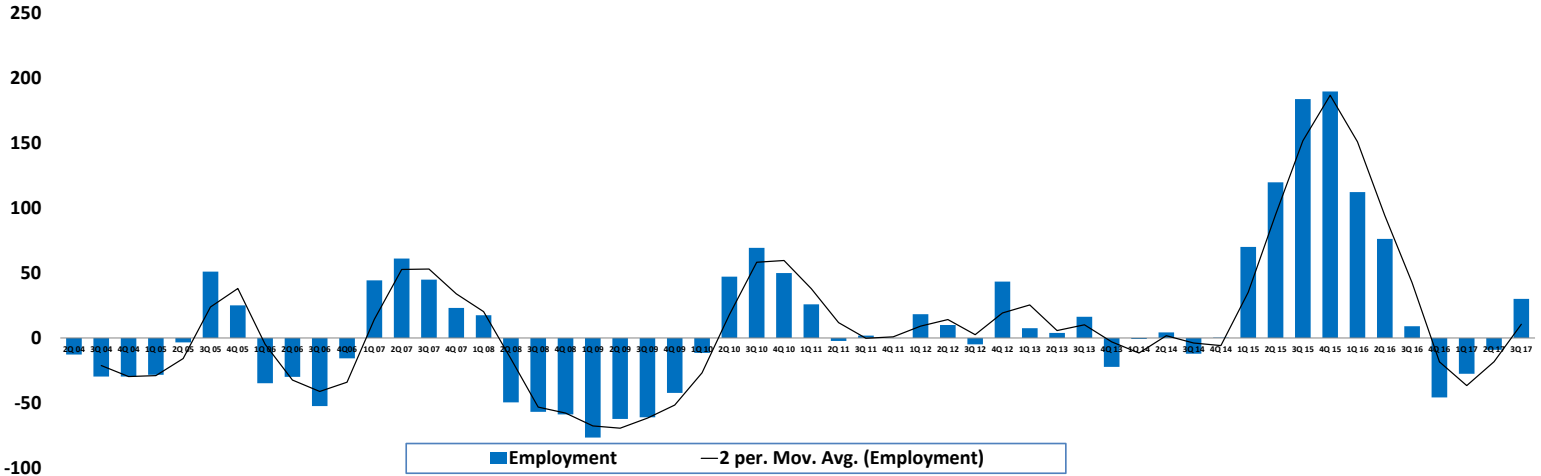
QUARTERLY AVERAGE EMPLOYMENT



+ 3.7%

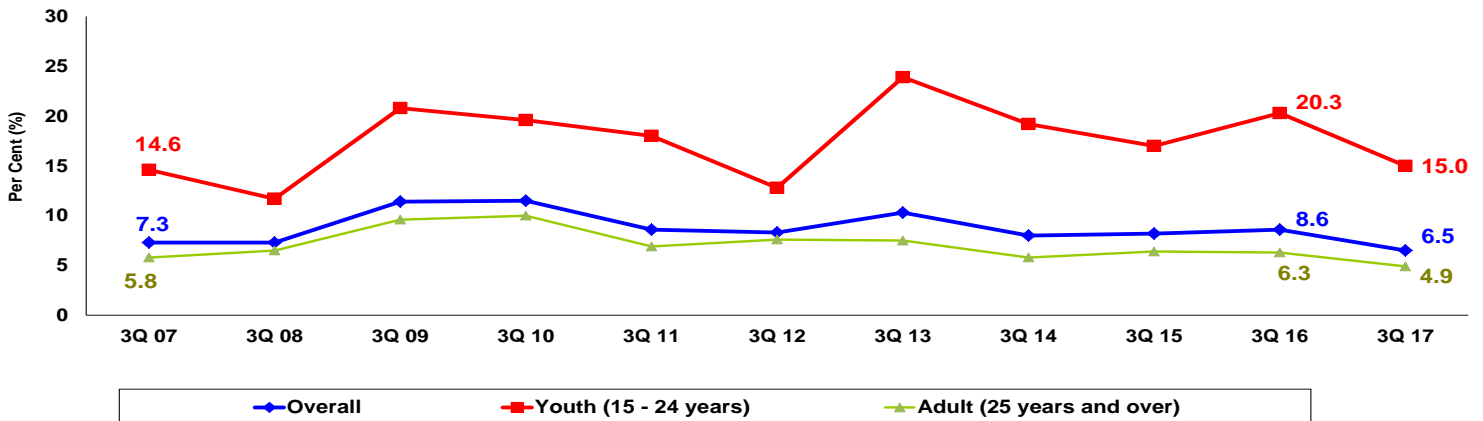
The number of persons who found work grew at an annualized rate of 3.7% or 30,100 persons
