- Heart Lake Road
- Clark Boulevard
- Dixie Road

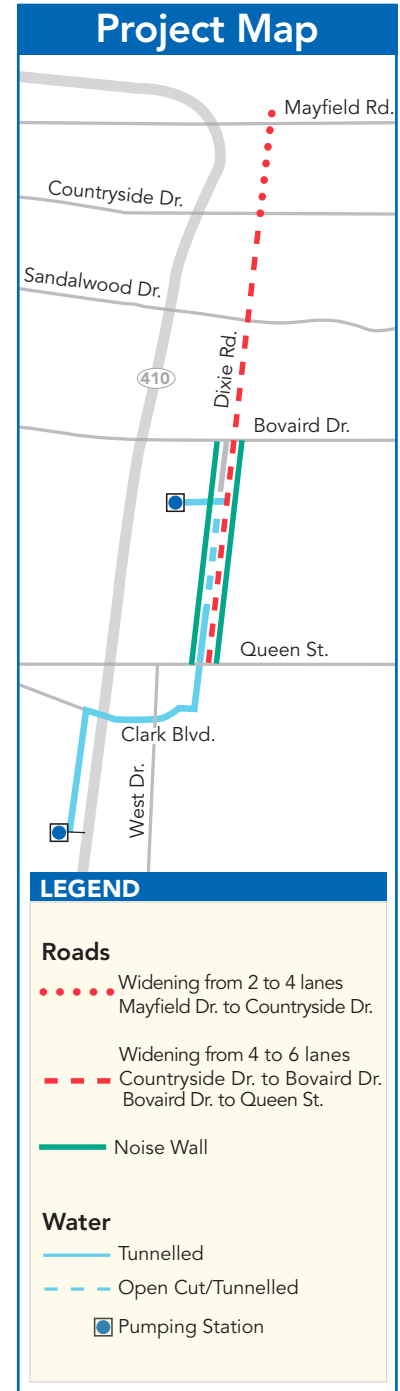
## What's happening, when and why?

**We are:**

- Installing new watermains
- Improving two pumping stations

**After that, we will:**

- Replace noise walls
- Widen Dixie Road
- Create multi-use trails along Dixie Road

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# Watermains

We must upgrade our drinking water system as Brampton continues to mature and grow. To maintain a constant water supply for the community and to help meet new demand, we are improving two water pumping stations and building new watermains between them.

We will install new watermains by **tunnelling**:

- Heart Lake Road from the Beckett Sproule Reservoir and Pumping Station south of Glidden Road to Clark Boulevard;
- East on Clark Boulevard to Dixie Road;
- North on Dixie Road to Howden Boulevard.

Because the work is being done underground, we won't cut long trenches in the road. We will work in construction compounds, similar to the one shown here, at key locations. Although these compounds will be in the boulevards, there will be lane reductions in the compound areas.

**Timing: Spring 2020 – Winter 2022**

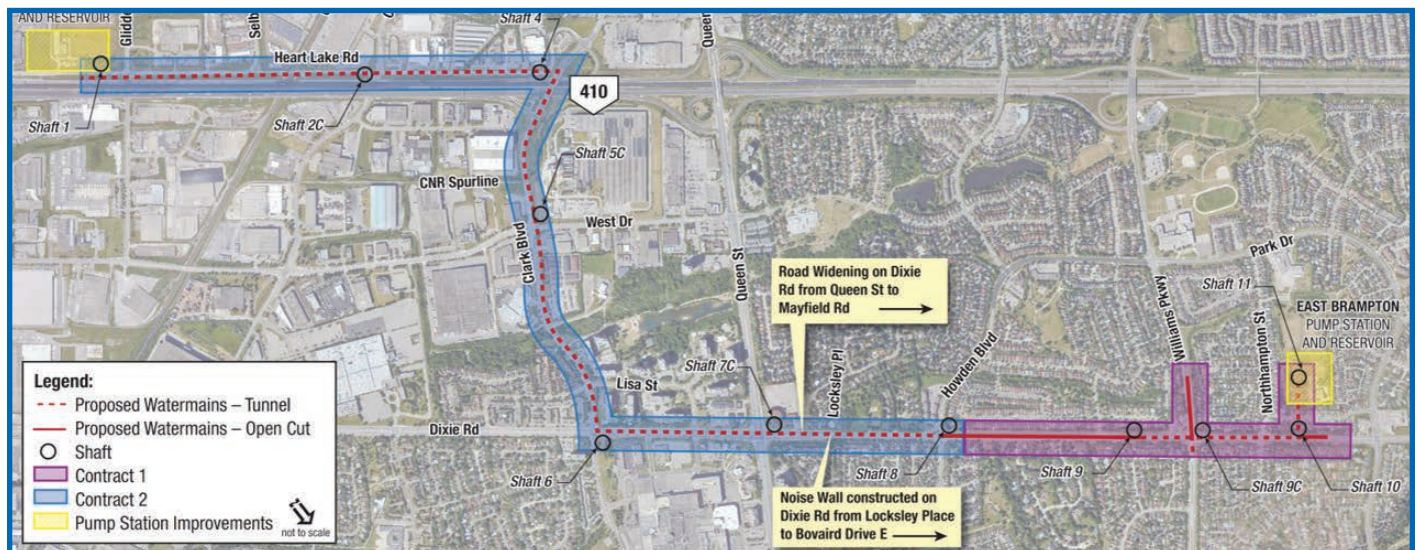


We will install new watermains by a **mixture of open-cutting and tunnelling**:

- West side of Dixie Road from Howden Boulevard to North Park Drive;
- To the East Brampton Reservoir and Pumping Station on Nanport Drive.

**Open-cutting** means a trench will be dug in the boulevard and the pipe will be put in the trench, which will then be backfilled.

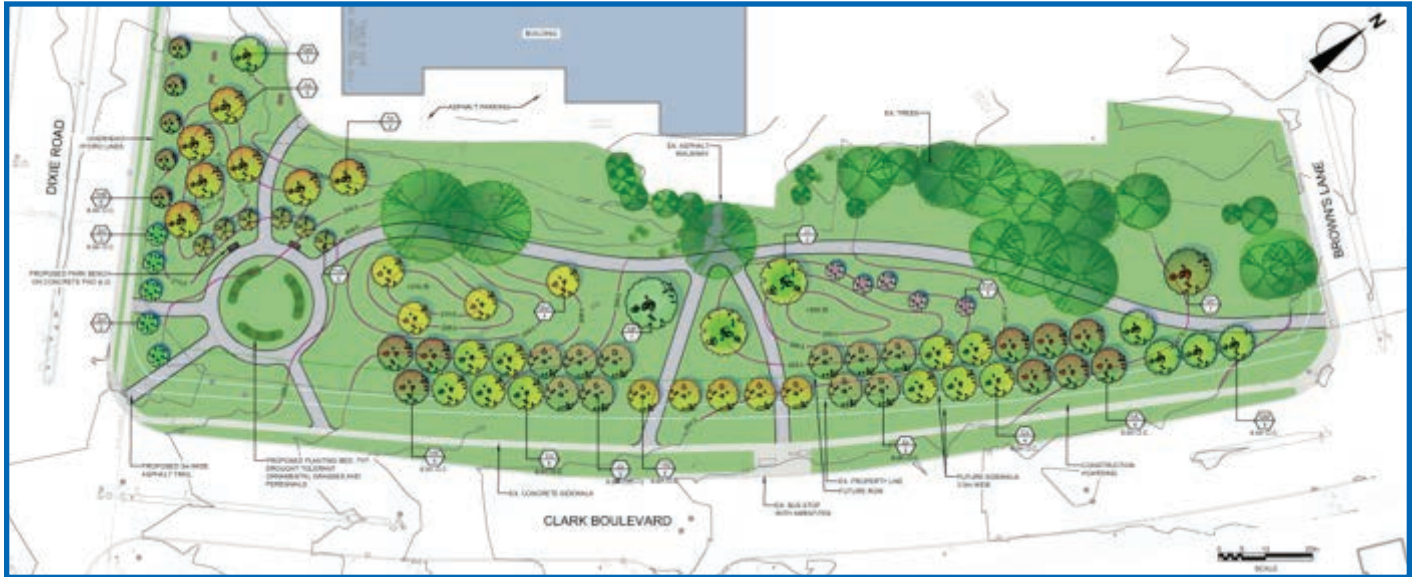
**Timing: Fall 2019 – Summer 2021**



# Restoring the Area When We're Finished

We know that construction work can seem messy. But when we're finished, the area will look better than ever.

For instance, we're planning a space like this for the corner of Dixie Road and Clark Boulevard (preliminary artist's concept):



## East Brampton Pumping Station

We are expanding and improving East Brampton Pumping Station and Reservoir on Nanport Road. Upgrades will include changes to the buildings and in the yard area around the reservoir. The work will be done in stages to minimize impacts on water supply in peak demand periods.

**Timing: Underway – Fall 2023**

# What's coming next?

We are still in the planning stages for the following. We'll let you know our plans closer to construction.

## Noise Walls

The noise walls along Dixie Road between Queen Street and Bovaird Drive, and some sections between Bovaird Drive and Sandalwood Parkway, need to be replaced. The existing wooden walls will be replaced with concrete walls, like the one shown in the picture.



## Road Widening

Dixie Road is a main north-south route and is very busy at certain times of the day. To keep traffic moving safely, we are widening the road in three stages.

- **North of Mayfield Road to Countryside Drive:**  
2 lanes to 4 lanes.
- **Countryside Drive to Bovaird Drive:**  
4 lanes to 6 lanes.
- **Bovaird Drive to Queen Street:**  
4 lanes to 6 lanes.



## Multi-use Trails

Many people enjoy walking, skateboarding, rollerblading or cycling so we are installing multi-use trails along Dixie Road in conjunction with the road-widening work.
