NOTICE OF TRAFFIC IMPACTS Mayfield Road at Coleraine Drive

The Region of Peel has been working in your neighborhood to install new watermains along Mayfield Road. This work is required to maintain and improve existing water services.

At this stage of the project, we need to reinstate concrete curbs and repave across the eastbound lanes of Mayfield Road.

Traffic impacts

Temporary lane reductions and lane shifts will be required to complete this work. From **Monday, July 25** to **Wednesday July 27, 2022,** traffic will be reduced to a single lane in each direction on Mayfield Road at Coleraine. During this time, truck traffic making right turns from southbound Coleraine Drive to westbound Mayfield Road may find it difficult to make the turn. It may also be difficult for trucks making left turns from eastbound Mayfield Road to northbound Coleraine Drive and will likely cause traffic delays on Mayfield Road west of Coleraine Drive due to temporary removal of the left turn lane on Mayfield Road. It is recommended that truck traffic find an alternate route during this time.

We ask for your patience and will try to minimize any delays.


