PROJECT UPDATE

INTERSECTION OF HURONTARIO STREET AND ROBERT SPECK PARKWAY APRIL 25 – JUNE 30, 2016 (WEATHER PERMITTING)

What are we doing?

- Installing a 400-mm watermain across Hurontario Street at Robert Speck Parkway

What does this mean for drivers?

The following lanes are closed:

- **Westbound Robert Speck Parkway:**
 - One through lane is closed (one through lane is open)
 - No right turns to northbound Hurontario Street are allowed on a red light
 - Right turns are allowed on a green light
- **Southbound Hurontario Street:**
 - Right-turn lane is closed
- **Northbound Hurontario Street:**
 - One through lane is closed (two through lanes are open)
- **Eastbound Robert Speck Parkway:**
 - No change

What does this mean for pedestrians?

- From time to time, **sidewalks** on the north-east and north-west corners of the intersection will be closed
- The following **crosswalks** are closed:
 - Across Hurontario Street on the north side of Robert Speck Parkway
 - Across Robert Speck Parkway on both the east and west sides of Hurontario Street
- Please cross safely at the nearest signalized crosswalk
