## WORK IN SHERIDAN HOMELANDS AREA

The following summarizes the work underway in the Sheridan Homelands Residents Association area:

### **Watermains:**

The Region of Peel is installing watermains on Speakman Drive, Sheridan Park Drive, within Sheridan Park and on Benedet Drive. These installations are part of a larger project where aging watermains are being replaced from the Herridge Pump Station on Sheridan Park Drive to Hurontario Street at Mineola Road, and includes a tunnelled crossing of the QEW and tunnelling work on Benedet Drive.

The project began in fall 2018 and is expected to be completed in spring 2021. The QEW tunnel and work on Benedet Drive is now completed and only work north of the QEW remains. It is anticipated that the underground construction will be completed in late fall 2020 with restoration occurring in spring 2021. Currently, there is a road closure in place on Speakman Drive, east of Flavelle Boulevard, which is expected until August 28, 2020. After this section opens, there are no other road closures anticipated, but there will be lane reductions as the work continues.

### **Herridge Pumping Station:**

The construction at Herridge Pumping Station started in spring 2020 and is expected to be complete by fall 2021. The purpose is to expand the pumping station and complete electrical upgrades to increase the consistency of our water delivery system. A section of the multi-use trail on the southern side of Sheridan Park Drive was closed to accommodate a temporary access road for construction materials to be delivered and personnel to access the site. For safety, this section of the trail will need to remain closed for the duration of the project. We are currently looking to see if we can make some changes to the sequence of work to reopen it sooner. During this time, we are asking residents to cross the street at either of the two intersections (Speakman Drive and Fifth Line West) and use the sidewalk on the northern side of the road.

### **Sanitary Sewers:**

We are completing trenchless spot, pipe and manhole repairs on sanitary sewers in various locations. Trenchless spot repairs are the least invasive rehabilitation method for a sewer. Work is done from above ground and usually consists of cleaning the sewer and applying a felt or fibreglass resin patch. The repairs require no excavation and are fast, cost-effective and efficient. On average the repairs take anywhere from 45 minutes to two hours for a more complex repair. Vehicles and machinery must keep running during the work. ### **Road work on Erin Mills Parkway:**

The rehabilitation of Erin Mills Parkway from Fowler Drive to south of Highway 403 is nearly complete. The final stage of resurfacing is underway and is scheduled for completion by mid to late August.

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
