- Completed the looping of the existing watermain in the cul-de-sac of Wellsborough Place and Glastonbury Place.

Why?

- To upgrade the water system as part of the Region of Peel's State of Good Repair program.

Restoration

- The road pavement on both streets has been restored by the Region of Peel's contractor in preparation of the City of Mississauga's resurfacing project in your neighborhood.
- Concrete restoration, curb and sidewalk, will be permanently restored by the City of Mississauga's resurfacing project.
- Also, topsoil and sod will be placed as part of the City of Mississauga's resurfacing project.

- The City of Mississauga anticipates the completion of the road rehabilitation of your neighbor this summer, 2017.
