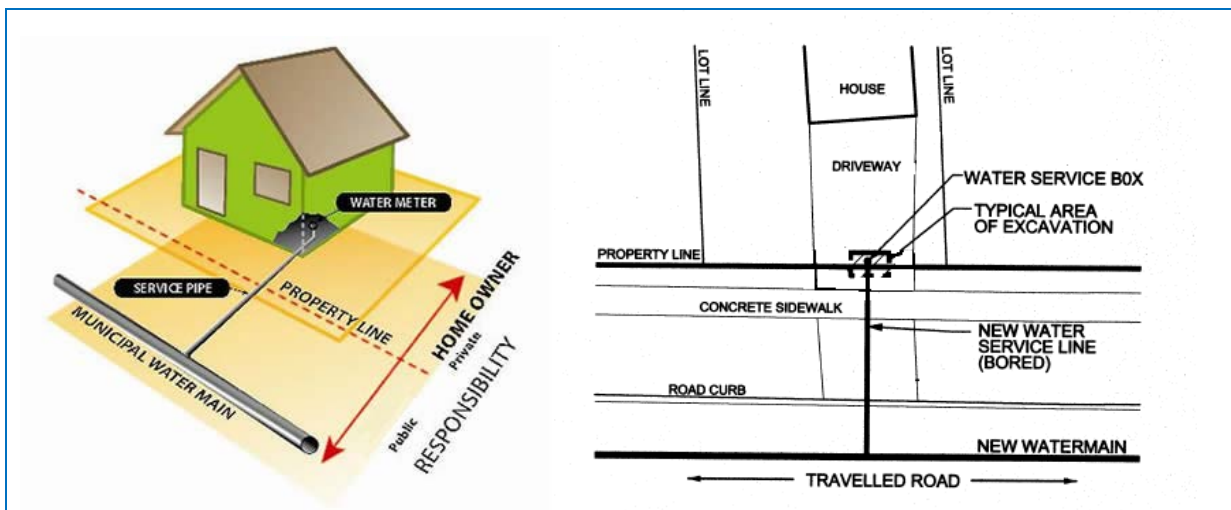
PROJECT UPDATE

WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT

CHURCH STREET FROM MAIN STREET TO VIC JOHNSTON ARENA, OLD PINE STREET FROM QUEEN STREET SOUTH TO CHURCH STREET AND MILL STREET FROM QUEEN STREET SOUTH TO WYNDHAM STREET
CITY OF MISSISSAUGA

Update

- The new watermain on Church Street, Old Pine Street and Mill Street have now been installed. The next phase is to commission the watermain and put them into service. Properties on these streets will now have their individual water lines transferred from the old watermain to the new watermain.
- A new water service line will be brought up to the property line where a new water service box will also be installed. Where possible your water line will be brought up to the property line using trenchless methods. However, the area around the water service box will be excavated.



When?

- We expect to start work on or about April 5, 2017, starting on Mill Street, followed by Church Street and Old Pine Street.
- The project should be completed before November 2017 (including Queen St. South). All work is under warranty for two years from the completion date.
- We will start restoring the road when all water system replacements and transfers are complete, and as weather permits.
