

# NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION SANITARY SEWER AND WATERMAIN IMPROVEMENTS, SOUTHEAST MISSISSAUGA

## The Study

The Region of Peel has initiated a Schedule 'B' Environmental Assessment (EA) for sanitary sewer and watermain improvements near Mattawa Ave. in the City of Mississauga. This work is needed to improve water and wastewater sewer and watermain conditions. Through the Class EA study, the recommended solution includes rehabilitating the existing sanitary sewer on Dundas St. East and installing a new sanitary sewer on Mattawa Ave. from Dundas St. East to the CP Rail line next to Little Etobicoke Creek. The study also recommended installing a new watermain from Mattawa Ave. south to Caterpillar Rd., passing the CP Rail line and crossing Little Etobicoke Creek. The watermain at the end of Wharton Way will also be looped to improve water flow and quality.



#### **The Process**

A Project File Report (PFR) was prepared to document the Class EA planning and decision-making process used in developing the recommended solution. The results of the study will be available for review for 30 days starting October 24, 2019 and ending November 23, 2019.
